- Press conferences
- Alumni and other special events
- Community outreach

Responsibilities

- Attend and shoot games (in various sports) and other athletics related events as assigned
- Pick up and turn in memory card before and after each event worked unless otherwise specified by the SID (photos/videos are property of William Jewell College and may not be used for any personal platforms or to promote any business)
- Assist with uploading and tagging photos on the College's photo archive

Equipment Used & Responsibility

- Ability to provide own DSLR or mirrorless camera – ***preferred***
- Working knowledge of a DSLR or mirrorless camera

- Commit to be a good student first and foremost
 - Enrolled full-time as a student at William Jewell College
 - Maintain good academic and behavioral standing with the institution
- Knowledge and understanding of various sports and anticipate action
- Work as a member of a team
- Take initiative (this position requires you to shoot an event from start to finish)
